WHEREAS, the City of Asheville and Buncombe County, operating on a temporary permit, are allowed until June 30, 1963 to continue dumping raw sewage into the French Broad River; and

WHEREAS, due to the financial condition of the various water and sewer districts in Buncombe County, such legislation is needed to carry out the provisions for the disposal system in Asheville and Buncombe County; and

WHEREAS, after careful study of the proposed bill entitled "An Act to Provide for the Creation and Enlargement of Metropolitan Sewage Districts and for the Issuance Thereby of General Obligation Bonds and Revenue Bonds," prepared by Mitchell, Pershing, Shetterly and Mitchell, dated March 18, 1961, the Board of County Commissioners of Buncombe County is of the opinion that it is necessary to have said bill passed on a statewide level in order to enable the various water and sewer districts to comply with provisions of the law as previously laid down by the North Carolina General Assembly.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Board of County Commissioners of Buncombe County go on record as requesting the Buncombe County Legislators and the State Stream Sanitation Committee to use their efforts and influence in obtaining the enactment of said bill.
