## RESOLUTION RE: ACCEPTANCE OF ELECTRICAL WORK BID FOR CRESCENT HILL SEWAGE TREATMENT PLANT ADOPTED.

A special meeting of the Metropolitan Sewerage District Board was held in the Board Room 501, City Building, Asheville, North Carolina at 3:00 p. m. on Friday, August 7, 1970.

Mr. J. H. Longshore, appointed by the County to fill the unexpired term of Kenneth Martin, was sworn in as a new member of the Metropolitan Sewerage District Board by Hazel W. Barker, Assistant Clerk of Superior Court.
